THE BIG EXHIBITION

An exhibition of contemporary art in your school!

Under its colorful marquees, **Musee Ambulant** presents a selection of artworks by professional artists and artisans from across the country. Interactive tours as well as creative workshops are offered, allowing students to experience a rich and fun encounter with contemporary art within the walls of the school!

*Requires an exclusive access to a gymnasium or a large room for the duration of the exhibition's stay. For a stay of three days or more, an open event can be organized to share this exhibition with the community. Outdoor activity possible.



SECRETS OF THE WOODS

An augmented reality art journey uncovering secret stories!

Following a trail of silk printed artworks installed in the school or outdoors, students will be surprised to discover augmented reality animations by **Marie-France Tremblay**, uncovering the forest's hidden stories.

A paint pen creative workshop will then allow your students to imagine their own!

*Requires high-speed internet access (through wifi or mobile coverage); can be installed inside the school or outdoors (school yard or nearby natural area).



UNDER THE CATKINS

When Art and Nature meet!

Adapted to both indoors and outdoors, *Under the Catkins* is an artwork to be discovered standing, seated or even lying down! This installation of ceramic sculptures is our mobile version of a monumental creation by well-known Huron-Wendat artist **Ludovic Boney**. This versatile proposal invites students to put their own creativity into practice by shaping individual sculptures (in clay or ice) and creating a collective work inspired by the surrounding ecological environment.



ARROWHEAD SASH WORK

Creating ties with a rich heritage!

Inspired by master artisan **Catherine Lessard's** contemporary arrowhead sash works, students will learn about this unique technique and its patterns, fruit of the rich encounter between French, English and First Nations' traditions. Sparking conversation about cultural diversity and the transmission of intangible heritage, this new Musee Ambulant activity weaves meaningful connections with social issues through art.



VIEWS FROM THE FIELDS

Reflecting on agricultural heritage through photography

Through the discovery of a series of photographs by **Meriol Lehmann**, our team will lead a discussion on various historical and socioeconomic changes that affect rurality, a central theme in the artist's work. Trans-disciplinary and designed to support a creative and critical use of new technologies, a digital collage workshop will bring students to use archives photographs and engage with issues pertaining to visual arts, history and civic engagement.

THE TELEPORTER

Art that travels between the virtual and the real world!

By exploring through touch a series of small sculptures by Marie-Fauve Bélanger, students will live a sensory experience of artistic discovery and will then create combining modeling and 3D-scanning. Thanks to our portable 3D scanning device, nicknamed the *Teleporter*, participants will learn more about digital 3D technologies and experience a unique creative workshop, blurring the lines between Art and Tech!

GIF animations of the students' creations and 3D-printable files will be produced, for printing through school's 3Dprinters or Musee Ambulant's (additional fees apply)
